Responsibilities & Application Requirements

Staff Writer

Responsibilities:

Fox & Hedgehog works in non-thematic, two-week publishing cycles. Writers are expected to contribute a certain number of articles per semester, and to submit pitches about a month in advance of publication date. Staff Writers will also reach out to guest contributors, and work with Editors in developing their pieces.

Application:

Staff Writers will be expected to display strong writing, reasoning, and analytical skills. Applicants are asked to submit two (2) writing samples (500-word limit each). These pieces should be argumentative, analytical, and relevant to current global affairs. They may be opinion pieces or expository works and may be extracts from longer pieces. Applicants are also asked to submit a 300-word personal statement describing their motivations, interests, and vision for their role in the writing team.

The Managing Editors will independently review the pieces, then inform candidates about whether they have been selected for an interview.
